A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 64-S-54 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street, and authorizing payment of second draw to contractor.

WHEREAS the City Council did on July 21, 1964, pass Ordinance No. 664 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street, by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 64-S-54 therefor; and
