

RESOLUTION NO. 1128

WHEREAS the City has purchased a site for a municipal building and related structures, with the intent to form thereon a complex of public buildings, and on which site there is presently an unoccupied area; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Bellevue City Library has expressed a desire to locate the new library presently being designed, and being financed by a bond issue approved by the voters in November of 1964, on such unoccupied area; and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Council to cooperate with said Board, realizing that said Board has the management and control of the proposed library;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Bellevue does hereby accept the recommendation of the Board of Trustees of the Bellevue City Library to locate the new library, authorized by the voters in November of 1964, on that portion of the site of the Municipal Building, located at 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington, which is unoccupied, and to the west and northwest of the Municipal Building.

Section 2. The presently unoccupied portion of the Municipal Building site was originally intended to be used in the future for other public buildings, and the location of the library thereon will cause more land to be required to the south of the site.


Section 3. It is understood that the City Council will furnish funds toward the purchase of four additional acres of land, contingent upon these funds being substantially matched by funds from the Library Services Construction Act.
