RESOLUTION NO. 1129

A RESOLUTION adopting Comprehensive Plan Supplement Nos. 8A, 9 and 10.

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 706 (1) directs the Planning Commission to continue to observe the development of the City in relation to the Comprehensive Plan, and (2) directs that, where development or the absence of development indicates a condition, problem, new element, or expansion, unforeseen and not anticipated or appreciated by the Plan, that the Planning Commission shall study the subject; and

WHEREAS after due study and deliberation the Planning Commission has made recommendation to the City Council of the adoption of Comprehensive Plan Supplements No. 8A, 9 and 10; now therefore
