RESOLUTION NO. 1130

ORIGINAL

A RESOLUTION regarding the Lake Hills annexation election; accepting a petition therefor, approving same, and notifying petitioners of such approval.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That certain Petition for Annexation to the City of Bellevue, Washington, filed with the City Council on March 4, 1965 under Clerk's receiving no. 881, is accepted and approved.

Section 2. The property in the area encompassed by said Petition shall not, upon annexation, be assessed and taxed to pay for any portion of the then outstanding indebtedness of the City contracted prior to, or existing at, the date of annexation.

Section 3. The administration is hereby directed to notify the petitioners of this approval by publication in the manner required by R.C.W. 35.13.040.

Section 4. The cost of conducting the proposed election shall be paid for by the City of Bellevue.

Section 5. That copies of this resolution shall be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington.
