RESOLUTION NO. 1135

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of 117th Avenue N.E., within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Keith G. Massart for the vacation of a portion of 117th Avenue N.E., in the City of Bellevue, and further described as follows:

The southerly 246 feet of the following described tract: That portion of 117th Avenue N.E. in Section 28, Township 25 N., Range 5 E. W.M., King County, Washington, beginning at the northwest corner of said Section; thence east along the north line of said Section 50 feet to the true point of beginning; thence south parallel to the west line of said Section 515.40 feet; thence east parallel to the north line 60 feet; thence north parallel to said west line 515.40 feet to the north line of said Section; thence west to the true point of beginning. LESS State Highway,

on the 6th day of April, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
