RESOLUTION NO. 1137

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate that portion of N.E. 2nd Street west of Highway 405 as platted in Fir Creek Addition, within the City of Bellevue.

ORIGINAL

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of George H. Wood for the vacation of a portion of N.E. 2nd Street, in the City of Bellevue, and further described as follows:

That portion of N.E. 2nd Street west of Highway 405 as platted in Fir Creek Addition, Vol. 44 of Plats, Page 89, records of King County, Washington,

on the 6th day of April, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
