RESOLUTION NO. 1143

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 64-L-60 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E., from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street, and authorizing payment of third draw to contractor

WHEREAS the City Council did on August 4, 1964, pass Ordinance No. 675 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E., from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street by installing a street lighting system thereon, and did create Local Improvement District No. 64-L-60 therefor; and

WHEREAS Said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant No. 1, dated December 8, 1964	\$2,246.42
Warrant No. 2, dated January 21, 1965	5,149.99

AND WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of March 29, 1965 approved and recommended payment to General Service Electric of the sum of \$2,806.74; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$ 2,806.74 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
