RESOLUTION NO. 1144

ORIGINAL

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 62-S-31 for the improvement of Main Street from 104th Avenue N.E. to 108th Avenue N.E., and authorizing payment of third draw to contractor.

WHEREAS the City Council did on July 7, 1964, pass Ordinance No. 663 for the improvement of Main Street from 104th Avenue N.E. to 108th Avenue N.E., by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 62-S-31 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:


Warrant Nos. 1 through 13, dated October 9, 1964	\$12,793.95
Warrant Nos. 14 through 27, dated November 9, 1964	13,010.17

AND WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of April 5, 1965 approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bulldozing Inc. the sum of \$18,232.04;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$ 18,232.04 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Grande and Co., Inc., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
