RESOLUTION NO. 1153

ORIGINAL

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of Jacob Kamber Rd. #2, located approximately at 133rd S.E. and S.E. 19th, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Charles A. and Virginia M. Koon, for the vacation of that portion of the following-described property which was deeded to King County for County road by deed recorded in Volume 855 of Deeds, Page 368, in King County, Washington:

The south half of the West three fourths of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 3, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington EXCEPT the south 330 feet; EXCEPT the west 330 feet; and EXCEPT the north 15 feet; and EXCEPT portion thereof deeded to King County for county road by deed recorded in Volume 855 of Deeds, Page 368, in King County, Washington,

on the 1st day of June, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
