RESOLUTION NO. 1160

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of the Bellevue-Redmond Road, within the City of Bellevue.

ORIGINAL

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Tum-A-Lum Lumber Co. and others, for the vacation of a portion of the Bellevue-Redmond Road, in the City of Bellevue, and further described as follows:

That portion of Otto Pletteplace County Road as condemned in King County Superior Court Cause No. 99829, adjoining lots 33, 34, 77 and 78, and vacated George Street (Northeast 10th Street) as shown in the plat of Brierwood Park, according to the plat thereof recorded in volume 17 of plats, page 18, records of King County, Washington, and lying northwesterly of a line 30 feet northwesterly of and parallel to the centerline of Northeast Redmond-Bellevue Revision Road, as conveyed to King County by deed recorded under auditor's file no. 2555191,

on the 6th day of July, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 16th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
