RESOLUTION NO. 1167

A RESOLUTION adopting Planning Supplement
No. 2D.


WHEREAS Ordinance No. 706 (1) directs the Planning Commission to continue to observe the development of the City in relation to the Comprehensive Plan, and (2) directs that, where development or the absence of development indicates a condition, problem, new element, or expansion, unforeseen and not anticipated or appreciated by the Plan, that the Planning Commission shall study the subject; and

Section 1. Planning Supplement No. 2D filed under Clerk's receiving no. 925, is hereby adopted.


