RESOLUTION NO. 1168

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 64-L-60 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street; authorizing final payment to contractor and other miscellaneous bills.

WHEREAS the City Council did on August 4, 1964, pass Ordinance No. 675 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E., from N.E. 8th Street to N.E. 10th Street by installing a street lighting system thereon, and did create Local Improvement District No. 64-L-60 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant No. 1, dated December 8, 1964	\$2,246.42
Warrant No. 2, dated January 21, 1965	5,149.99
Warrant No. 3, dated April 12, 1965	2,806.74

AND WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of May 18, 1965, approved and recommended payment to General Service Electric of the sum of \$967.20; and

WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$2,950.88 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.



and blanks, extended or used on the part of the City Clerk or Treasurer in connection with the improvement, and all other expenses incidental thereto as required or provided by law of the State of Washington and ordinances of the City of Bellevue shall be allocated to and borne by the properties within the improvement district, in accordance with the special benefits conferred, and the costs assessed against the individual lots in accordance with the statutory zone and termini method. PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the City shall pay fifty per cent (50%) of the public's portion of the cost of this improvement. The City's portion of the cost of this improvement, as provided above, shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of Street Improvement Bonds, sale of which was heretofore authorized by Ordinance No. 431, passed by the City Council on February 14, 1961; from the proceeds of the sale of General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds, 1964, sale of which was heretofore authorized by Ordinance No. 645, passed by the City Council on April 7, 1964; from proceeds of the half cent of additional motor vehicle fuel and use fuel excise tax allocated to the City for the construction, improvement and repair of arterial highways; and from current expense and street funds. The improvement shall be paid for under the mode of "Payment by Bonds," by means of assessments against the various properties as aforesaid, all as provided by statute and ordinance for local improvement districts.

Section 4. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council or a committee thereof, to be held in the Municipal Building of the City, 111 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., Daylight Saving Time, on the 3 day of August, 1965, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.


Section 5. That the City Manager shall submit to the City Council at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.
