RESOLUTION NO. 1180

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of 108th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 38th and the N.P.R.R. right-of-way, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Sterling Theatres Co. and others, for the vacation of a portion of 108th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 38th and the N.P.R.R. right-of-way, in the City of Bellevue, and further described as follows:

That portion of 108th Avenue NE in the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 20, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M. described as the west 30 feet of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter lying north of the northwesterly right-of-way margin of NE 38th Street, situated in King County, Washington.

on the 19 day of October, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
