A RESOLUTION regarding Planned Unit Development No. 1; expressing the concurrence of the Council with the recommendation of the Planning Commission, and authorizing Conditional Grant.

ORIGINAL

WHEREAS the owner of the property described below filed an application for a Conditional Grant with the City, and such was thereafter processed and tentatively approved by the Planning Commission, and in turn by the Council by Resolution No. 1148 passed April 20, 1965; and

WHEREAS the final working drawings have now been submitted to the City Building Department for a building permit, and such plans have in turn been examined by the Planning Commission and compared with the preliminary drawings filed under Clerk's receiving number 892 on the basis of which the tentative approval was originally given, and the Commission has approved such final working drawings, and has recommended to the Council that the Conditional Grant be authorized; now therefore


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby concur with the Planning Commission, and does hereby authorize the Conditional Grant to Richard Hedreen, and as to the following described parcel:

The west 185 feet of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ in Sec. 29, Township 25 N, Range 5 E, W.M., less roads; King County, Washington.

Section 2. Those certain final working drawings, filed under Clerk's receiving number 968, which drawings form the basis for the issuance of the building permit for Planned Unit Development No. 1, are hereby approved by this reference.


