RESOLUTION NO. 1191

A RESOLUTION regarding Chism Park; affirming the intention to acquire and develop, and directing the administration to make application for financial assistance.

WHEREAS the City is desirous of acquiring and developing Chism Park; and

WHEREAS the City is desirous of obtaining assistance from the (1) State of Washington Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation and the (2) Department of the Interior Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, in such effort; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to make application to said governmental agencies for such financial assistance, and to reaffirm the intention of the City Council to acquire and develop said park; now therefore


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby declare its intention to acquire and develop the parcel of land commonly known as Chism Park.

Section 2. The administrative staff of the City is hereby authorized and directed to make application to (1) State of Washington Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation and the (2) Department of the Interior Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, for financial assistance in the acquisition and development of said Chism Park.


