RESOLUTION NO. 1193

A RESOLUTION regarding Hidden Valley Park; affirming the intention of the City Council to develop the same, and directing the administration to make application for financial assistance therefor.

WHEREAS the City is desirous of developing Hidden Valley Park; and

WHEREAS the City is desirous of obtaining assistance from the (1) State of Washington Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation and the (2) Department of the Interior Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, in such effort; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to make application to said governmental agencies for such financial assistance, and to reaffirm the intention of the City Council to develop said park; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby declare its intention to develop Hidden Valley Park.

Section 2. The administrative staff of the City is hereby authorized and directed to make application to (1) State of Washington Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation and the (2) Department of the Interior Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, for financial assistance in the development of said Hidden Valley Park.
