RESOLUTION NO. 1195

A RESOLUTION adopting City of Bellevue "1965 Revised and Extended Comprehensive Six Year Street Improvement Plan."

WHEREAS Chapter 195 of Laws of 1961 requires the legislative body of each city, prior to January 1, 1962 and pursuant to hearing thereon, to prepare and adopt a comprehensive street program for the ensuing six years; and

WHEREAS said statute does further direct that biennially thereafter the legislative body shall review the work accomplished under the program and determine current city street needs, and in addition allows such program to be revised by the Council at any time; and

WHEREAS a hearing was held at 8:00 p.m. on the 1st day of February, 1966, as to the advisability of adopting the revised and extended comprehensive street program for the ensuing six years; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Bellevue "1965 Revised and Extended Comprehensive Six Year Street Improvement Plan," in the total sum of \$ 4,503,000.00, and received under Clerk's receiving number 1003 is hereby adopted.

Section 2. That a certified copy of this resolution shall be filed with the Director of Highways not more than thirty (30) days after the adoption hereof.

Section 3. That biennially hereafter the Council shall review the work accomplished under said street program and determine the City's current street needs; and based on those findings shall prepare and, after public hearing thereon, adopt a revised and extended comprehensive street program.
