Resolution No. 1203

A RESOLUTION declaring the intention to order a local improvement for the installation of underground electric utility transmission lines on 100th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 10th Street, and on Main Street from 100th Avenue N.E. to 101st Avenue N.E.; setting forth the nature and extent thereof, setting a date for hearing objections thereto, and giving notice thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council to order the improvement of an area within the City comprised of the following-described continuous unit of the improvement:

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Section 2. That the area described in Section 1 hereof shall be improved by the construction and installation of certain underground electric utility transmission lines on 100th Avenue N.E. between Main Street and N.E. 10th Street, and Main Street between 100th Avenue N.E. and 101st Avenue N.E., including the securing of necessary easements and rights-of-way, and including ditching, the installation of conduits ducts, manholes and hand holes, covering with granulitic, backfilling, tamping, restoration to grade, and the installation of primary and secondary cables, transformers, switch gear, and other appurtenances consistent with good transmission line installations. All of the foregoing shall be in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted by the City Engineer.

Section 3. The Puget Sound Power & Light Company has heretofore contracted to pay an amount equal to the cost which they would have to pay to relocate their lines, plus fifty per cent (50%) of the additional cost due to locating such lines underground. All of the remaini hereinafter referred to as "public's," portion of the cost of this improvement, including the public's share of the estimated cost and expense of: (a) The improvement within street intersections. (b) All engineering and surveying necessary for the improvement, whether done under the supervision of the City Engineer or otherwise. (c) Acquisition of rights-of-way, property, easement and other facilities or rights-of-way; and also all of the estimated cost and expense of (d) all legal work and opinions incidental thereto. (e) Ascertaining the ownership of lots or parcels of land included within the assessment district. (f) Appraisals. (g) Advertising, mailing, posting and publishing all necessary notices. (h) Accounting, clerical labor and of books and blanks, extended or used on the part of the City Clerk or Treasurer in connection with the improvement, and all other expenses incidental thereto as required or provided by law of the State of Washington and ordinances of the City of Bellevue shall be allocated to and borne by the properties within the improvement district, in accordance with the special benefits conferred, and the costs assessed against the individual lots in accordance with the statutory zone and termini methof. PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the City shall pay fifty per cent (50%) of the public's portion of the cost of this improvement. The City's portion of the cost of this improvement, as provided above, shall be paid from the proceeds of the sale of Street Improvement Bonds, sale of which was heretofore authorized by Ordinance No. 431, passed by the City Council on February 14, 1961; from the proceeds of the sale of General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds, 1964, sale of which was heretofore authorized by Ordinance No. 645, passed by the City Council on April 7, 1964; from proceeds of the half cent of additional mater vehicle fuel and use fuel excise tax allocated to the City for the construction, improvement and repair of arterial highways; and from currer expense and street funds. The improvement shall be paid for under the made of "Payment by Bonds," by means of assessments against the various properties as aforesaid, all as provided by statute and ordinance for local improvement districts.

Section 4. That all persons who may desire to object thersto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a committee thereof, to be held in the Municipal Building of the City, lil - li6th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, on the <u>lst</u> day of <u>March 1966</u>, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

Section 5. That the City Manager shall submit to the City Council at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

Beginning at a point on the centerline of Main Street 424.81 ft, east of its intersection with the centerline of 100th Avenue SE; thence southerly from said point along a line that is tangent to the centerline of Southeast Bellevue Way to the centerline of said Southeast Bellevue Way; thence continuing along said centerline to a line that is 250 ft. south of and parallel with the centerline of Main Street; thence westerly along said parallel line to the centerline of 100th Avenue SE; thence northerly along said centerline to the centerline of NE Lake Washington Boulevard; thence west along centerline of NE Lake Washington Boulevard to a point of intersection of the southerly projection of the centerline of the alley in Blocks 3 and 4 of Lochleven Addition, as recorded in Volume 16 of Plats, Page 46, Records of King County; thence north along the southerly projected line of said alley and along the centerline of said alley to the centerline of NE 5th Street; thence north along the northerly projected centerline of said alley to the centerline of NE 8th Street; thence east along said centerline to a point 120 feet west of the centerline of 100th Avenue NE; thence north along a line 120 feet west and parallel with the centerline of 100th Avenue NE to a point 47 feet north of the centerline intersection of NE 10th Street and 100th Avenue NZ; thence east along a line 47 feet north of and parallel with the centerline of NE 10th Street to a line midway between 100th Avenue NE and 102nd Avenue N thence south to the centerline of NE 10th Street; thence east to a line midway between 100th Avenue NE and 102nd Avenue NE; thence south along said line to the centerline of NE 5th Street; thence east along said centerline to a point 330.82 ft. east of the centerline of 100th Avenue NE; thence south to a point on the centerline of NE 4th Stree 329.42 feet east of the centerline of 100th Avenue NE; thence west along the centerline of XZ 4th Street to intersection with a line midway between 100th Avenue NE and Link Avenue NE; thence southerly along said line midway between 100th Avenue NE & 102AA Ave. NE to its intersection with a line midway between NE 1st Street and Main Street; thence easterly along said line midway between NE 1st Street and Main Stre to its intersection with a line 424.81 ft. east of and parallel with 100th Avenue NE; thence southerly along said parallel line to the point of beginning.
