RESOLUTION NO. 1209

A RESOLUTION regarding the Council's intention to order a local improvement for the location, establishment and construction of 100th Ave. N.E. from Main St. to N.E. 10th, and Main St. from 100th Ave. N.E. to 101st Ave. N.E.; and amending Section 4 of Res. No. 1202.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Res. No. 1202, passed February 1, 1966, is hereby amended to read as follows:

> Section 4. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a committee thereof, to be held in the Municipal Building of the City, 111 - 116th Avenue 8.E., Bellevue, Washington, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, on the 15th day of March , 1966, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.
