RESOLUTION NO. 1209

A RESOLUTION regarding the Council's intention to order a local improvement for the location, establishment and construction of 100th Ave. N.E. from Main St. to N.E. 10th, and Main St. from 100th Ave. N.E. to 101st Ave. N.E.; and amending Section 4 of Res. No. 1202.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Res. No. 1202, passed February 1, 1966, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a committee thereof, to be held in the Municipal Building of the City, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, on the 15th day of March, 1966, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.
