RESOLUTION NO. 1220

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of 101st Avenue S.E. and Main Street, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Armin Rembe and others, for the vacation of:

Beginning at the NW corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 25 N, Range 5 E, W.M., thence N 89°47' E 525.45'; thence S 00°13' E 30 feet to the southerly right-of-way margin of Main Street and the true point of beginning; thence S 89°47' W 43.49' to point of curvature of a curve to the left having a radius of 22 feet; thence southwesterly along said curve 35.78 feet; thence S 03°24' E 46.54 feet to a point; thence northeasterly along a curve to the right having a radius of 65.49 feet 106.51' to the true point of beginning.

Situate in King County, Washington.

on the 3rd day of May, 1966, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
