RESOLUTION NO. 1227

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 63-S-43 for the improvement of 108th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 9th Street; authorizing payment of draw to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on June 16, 1964 pass Ordinance No. 661 for the improvement of 108th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 9th Street, by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 63-S-43 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant Nos. 1 through 33, dated December 21, 1964 **\$3**2,**1**57.40 Warrant Nos. 34 through 65, dated April 12, 1965 31,048.21 Warrant Nos. 66 through 78, dated April 28, 1966 12,037.45

AND WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the aboveentitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of April 27 , 1966, approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bulldozing, Inc. of the sum of \$15,628.22; and

WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement , to bear interest in acdistrict warrants in the amount of \$ 16,528.22 , to bear interest in cordance with the bid and contract of Grande & Co., Inc., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
