RESOLUTION NO. 1239

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 63-S-45 for the improvement of N.E. 4th Street from 108th Avenue N.E. to 114th Drive N.E., and authorizing payment of miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on July 21, 1964, pass Ordinance No. 662 for the improvement of N.E. 4th Street from 108th Avenue N.E. to 114th Drive N.E., by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 63-S-45 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$1,841.54 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Grande & Co., Inc., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
