RESOLUTION NO. 1262

A RESOLUTION regarding Planned Unit Development No. 5, and approving the preliminary proposal as modified.

WHEREAS the owner of the following-described property filed an application for Conditional Grant, by submitting a preliminary proposal to the City Planning Department for study of the proposed development and its vicinity; and

WHEREAS following the Department's review and finding that the preliminary proposal met the minimum defined standards, a public hearing was held before the Planning Commission, and thereafter the Commission did tentatively approve the proposed Conditional Grant, and did forward the same to the Council for review; and

WHEREAS the preliminary proposal has been modified by the Council; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does tentatively approve the proposed Conditional Grant, upon the application of Cougar Mountain Associates, as modified by the Council, and as to the following-described parcel:

The SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 27, TWP. 25 N., R. 5E., W.M., in King County, Washington; except the E. 30' for road; and except the S. 40' for road; and except the W. 30' of the N. 20' of the S. 50' for road.

Section 2. Those certain preliminary drawings, given Clerk's receiving number 1092, which drawings set and fix the designated conditions of the Planned Unit Development aforesaid, as modified by the Council, and commonly known as Planned Unit Development No. 5, are hereby approved by this reference.
