RESOLUTION NO. 1264

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 65-S-79 for the improvement of the streets in the Plat of Vuecrest; and authorizing payment of draw to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on May 3, 1966, pass Ordinance No. 813 for the improvement and reinstallation of streets in the Plat of Vuecrest, by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 65-S-79 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant Nos. 1 through 3, dated August 22, 1966 \$2,530.98

AND WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of September 15, 1966, approved and recommended payment to Washington Asphalt Co., Inc., of the sum of \$55,564.85


AND WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of Local Improvement District warrants in the amount of \$56,819.⁵⁵, to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Hughbanks Incorporated, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
