RESOLUTION NO. 1265

A RESOLUTION in regard to 65-5-87 for the construction of streets and sewers in the Cherry Crest area; and authorizing payment of draw to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on February 15, 1966, pass Ordinance No. 850 for the improvement of the Cherry Crest area by the construction and installation of streets and sewers, and did create Local Improvement District No. 65-S-87 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant Nos. 1 through 18, dated June 13, 1966 \$ 17,236.11
Warrant Nos. 19 through 24, dated August 9, 1966 5,810.79
Warrant Nos. 25 through 36, dated August 22, 1966 39,833.84

AND WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of September 15, 1966, approved and recommended payment to Berkes Construction Co., Inc., of the sum of \$50,405.76;

AND WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

Miscellaneous salaries, engineering services (August) \$ 1,196.88

M. Epstein, sewer easement 600.00

J. K. McLaughlin, mileage 43.18

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of Local Improvement District warrants in the amount of \$52,245 , to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Grande and Co., Inc., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
