RESOLUTION NO. 1270

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of N.E. 1st Street lying southeasterly of and adjacent to Meydenbauer Park, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Bickford and others for the vacation of:

That portion of N.E. 1st Street lying between the easterly right-of-way of Meydenbauer Park Road and the northerly extension of the east line of Lot 1, Block 7, plat of Lochleven, as recorded in Vol. 16, page 46, King County, Washington.

on the 1st day of November, 1966, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
