RESOLUTION NO. 1287

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of 112th Avenue N.E., between N.E. 28th Street and Northrup Way, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Baker for the vacation of:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 12, Block 7, Plat of Kirkland Syndicates 1st Addition to Seattle; thence northerly along the west lines of Blocks 7 and 5 to a line 30 feet south-westerly of and parallel with the centerline of Northrup Way; thence northwesterly along said parallel line to the west line of Taylor Avenue, as shown on said Plat; thence southerly along said west line to a point west of beginning; thence east to beginning, commonly known as 112th Avenue N.E., between N.E. 28th Street and Northrup Way.

All in King County, Washington.

on the 3rd day of January, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers of the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
