RESOLUTION NO. 1292

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of C. B. Howard Rd. No. 2 (Co. Rd. No. 940) also known as NE 21st Street, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Wolf for the vacation of:

That portion of C. B. Howard Rd. No. 2 (Co. Rd. No. 940) also known as $^{
m NE}$ 21st Street in the City of Bellevue lying easterly and southerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the easterly right-of-way margin of 140th Avenue NE and the southeasterly right-of-way margin of C. B. Howard Road No. 2 (50. Rd. No. 940); thence northerly along a line 30 feet easterly of and parallel to the centerline of said 140th Avenue NE to a line 60 feet southerly of and parallel to the north line of the south 1/5of the Northwest & of the Northeast & of Section 27, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; thence easterly along said parallel line to the southeasterly margin of said C. B. Howard Road and the terminal point.

on the 3d day of January, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
