RESOLUTION NO. 1304

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. 65-S-71 for the improvement of 102nd Avenue N.E. between N.E. 8th Street and N.E. 10th Street; and authorizing payment of draws to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS, the City Council did on August 16, 1966, pass Ordinance No. 923 for the improvement of 102nd Avenue N.E. between N.E. 8th Street and N.E. 10th Street, by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 65-S-71 therefor; and

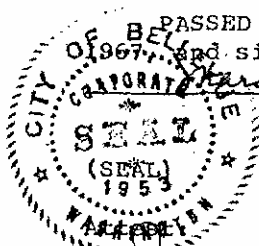
WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of January 17, 1967 and March 21, 1967, approved and recommended payment to Bass Construction, Inc., of the sums of \$3,605.49 and \$6,945.55 respectively;

AND WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

Sebastian Construction Co., sewer installation	\$ 300.62
Washington Asphalt Co., Inc., patching	339.83
Shorey, McLaughlin, Brown, engineering services	2,255.08
Lewis-Redford-Engineers, professional services	3,847.58

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$ 17,294.15, to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
