RESOLUTION NO. 1314

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing a petition to vacate a portion of N.E. 26th Street, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Pryde Development Co., Inc. for the vacation of:

That portion of N.E. 26th Street in the City of Bellevue lying Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 6, Block 5, Cherry Crest Plat No. 2; thence southerly to the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 6 of said Plat; thence easterly along the north line of said Lot 1 to the Northeast corner thereof; thence northerly to the Southeast corner of aforementioned Lot 6; thence westerly along the south line thereof to the point of beginning.

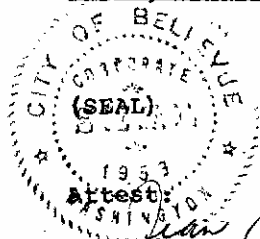
on the 4th day of April, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
