RESOLUTION NO. 1322

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. 66-SAN-96 for the construction of sanitary sewers in the vicinity of S.E. 30th Street, and for a distance of 1,250 feet easterly of the existing Metro trunk line; and authorizing payment of draw to contractor and other miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on October 4, 1966, pass Ordinance No. 938 for the improvement of an area generally described as S.E. 30th Street, and for a distance of 1,250 feet easterly of the existing Metro trunk line, by the construction of sanitary sewers, and did create Local Improvement District 66-SAN-96 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of March 21, 1967, approved and recommended payment to W. C. Frost Co. of the sum of \$3,968.38;
