RESOLUTION NO. 1329

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. 65-S-81 for the improvement of 120th Avenue N.E., from Bellevue-Redmond Road to Northrup Way; and authorizing payment of miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS, the City Council did on March 7, 1967, pass Ordinance No. 1012 for the improvement of 120th Avenue N.E., from Bellevue-Redmond Road to Northrup Way, by paving and otherwise improving the same, and did create Local Improvement District No. 65-S-81 therefor; and

WHEREAS costs have accrued, and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$ 6,862.74, to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
