WHEREAS the City is desirous of obtaining assistance from the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the improvement of the same; and


WHEREAS it is necessary to make application to said governmental agency for such financial assistance, and to reaffirm the intention of the City Council to develop and improve said park; now therefore
