RESOLUTION NO. 1337

A RESOLUTION declaring the intention to order a local improvement for the installation of underground electric utility transmission lines, underground telephone transmission lines and an approved street lighting system within the area generally described as Woodridge; setting forth the nature and extent thereof, setting a date for hearing objections thereto, and giving notice thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council to order the improvement of an area within the City comprised of the following-described continuous unit of the improvement:

The Plats of: Woodridge; Woodridge Division 2; Woodridge Division 3; Woodridge Division 4; Woodridge Division 5; Lot 1, Block 4, Woodridge Division 8 only; Norwood Village; Norwood Village No. 2; Norcrest; Linda Vista; Norwood Vista; Deaverdale; Lake Vista; Lots 5, 7, 8, Block 2, Woodmont; Lots 1 - 14 inclusive; Woodview; Lots 72, 73, 74, Woodview No. 2; Woodview No. 3; Manor Crest No. 2, except Lots 2 and 7; Woodcrest Terrace except Lot 9; also unplatted lands known as tax lot 85 of Section 9, Township 24N, Range 5E, and also tax lots 99 and 100, Section 4, Township 24N, Range 5E, W.M., King County, Washington.

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Section 2. That the area described in Section 1 hereof shall be improved by the construction and installation of underground electric utility distribution lines, underground telephone transmission lines and an approved street lighting system, including the securing of necessary easements and rights-of-way and including ditching, the installation of conduits, ducts, manholes, hand holes, covering with granular backfill, tamping, restoration to grade and the installation of primary and secondary cables, all distribution lines and services with the exception of the overhead high voltage transmission lines, transformers, switchgear, light standards and luminaires and other appurtenances consistent with good distribution line, telephone line and street lighting installations. All of the foregoing shall be in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted by the City Engineer.

Section 3. All of the cost of this improvement, including (a) The improvement within street intersections. (b) All engineering and surveying necessary for the improvement, whether done under the supervision of the City Engineer or otherwise. (c) Acquisition of rights-of-way, property, easement and other facilities or rights-of-way, and also all of the estimated cost and expense of (d) all legal work and opinions incidental thereto. (e) Ascertaining the ownership of lots or parcels of land included within the assessment district. (f) Appraisals. (g) Advertising, mailing, posting and publishing all necessary notices. (h) Accounting, clerical labor and of books and blanks, extended or used on the part of the City Clerk or Treasurer in connection with the improvement, and all other expenses incidental thereto as required or provided by law of the State of Washington and ordinances of the City of Bellevue shall be allocated to and borne by the properties within the improvement district, in accordance with the special benefits conferred, and the costs assessed against the individual lots on a per lot basis, each lot bearing an equal share of the cost of the improvement. The improvement shall be paid for under the mode of "Payment by Bonds," by means of assessments against the various properties as aforesaid, all as provided by statute and ordinance for local improvement districts.

Section 4. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a committee thereof, to be held in the Municipal Building of the City, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., Bellevue, Washington, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., Daylight Saving Time, on the 18th day of July, 1967, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

Section 5. That the City Manager shall submit to the City Council at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.
