RESOLUTION NO. 1348

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing to vacate a portion of 132nd Avenue S.E. in the vicinity of S.E. 30th Street, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Camblin and others for the vacation of:

That portion of 132nd Avenue S.E. in the City of Bellevue lying north of a line 30 feet north of the centerline of S.E. 30th Street and south of the westerly extension of the north line of Tract 20, Plat of Mercer Slough Garden Tracts, in King County, Washington.

on the 1st day of August, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing, and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
