RESOLUTION NO. 1349

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing to vacate a portion of N.E. 14th Street in the vicinity of 124th Avenue N.E., within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of One Twenty Four Investment Corporation and others for the vacation of:

That portion of northeast 14th Street lying between two parcels of property described below and extending easterly from 124th Avenue N.E. for a distance of 555.90 feet:

Parcel "A"

The west half of that portion of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 28, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., in King County, Washington, lying south of a line parallel with and 394.40 feet south of the northerly line of said subdivision and north of the north line of the south 519.73 feet of said subdivision; EXCEPT the west 30 feet thereof and EXCEPT that portion thereof lying within the east 30 feet of the west half of the south 12 acres of the north 24 acres of said northwest quarter of the southeast quarter.

Parcel "B"

South 519.73 feet of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 28, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., in King County, Washington, EXCEPT the east 725.00 feet thereof, and EXCEPT the north 30.00 feet thereof, and EXCEPT the west 30.00 feet thereof.

on the 18 day of July, 1967, at the hour or 8:00 o'clock P.M., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
