RESOLUTION NO. 1354

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. 65-S-78 for the improvement of S.E. 30th Street, from the Henry Richards Road easterly to the east line of the Plat of Mercer Slough Garden Tracts; and authorizing payment of draw to contractor.

WHEREAS the City Council did on October 4, 1966, pass Ordinance No. 939 for the improvement of S.E. 30th Street, from Henry Richards Road easterly to the east line of the Plat of Mercer Slough Garden Tracts, by paving and otherwise improving the same, which ordinance was thereafter amended by Ordinance No. 1041 passed June 6, 1967, and did create Local Improvement District No. 65-S-78 therefore; and

. WHEREAS said project has progressed, and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

AND WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project, and the Director of Public Works has, in writing and under date of July 5, 1967, approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bulldozing, Inc., of the sum of \$10,118.25;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of $\frac{10,118.25}{10,118.25}$, to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
