RESOLUTION NO. 1359

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing to vacate a portion of N.E. 18th Place in the vicinity of Northrup Road, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Sternco Land Co. and Atlantic Richfield Company for the vacation of:

That portion of N.E. 18th Place in the City of Bellevue lying as follows:

That portion of Northrup Road in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 27, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M., King County, Washington, described as follows: BEGINNING at the intersection of the southeasterly margin of Northrup Road (formerly the Otto Phetteplace Road, also known as C. B. Howard Road and N.E. 18th Place) as conveyed to King County by deed recorded under Auditor's file No. 913730 and the east line of said section 27; thence southwesterly and westerly along said road margin and along the southerly margin of the C. B. Howard Road (also known as N.E. 18th Place) as conveyed to King County by deed recorded under Auditor's file No. 817283, a distance of 63 feet, more or less, to the west line of the east 50 feet of said northeast quarter, and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along said road margin 333 feet, more or less, to a point where said C. B. Howard Road widens from 30 feet to 50 feet south of the center line of said road; thence northerly on a radial line of the curve on said road 60 feet to the northwesterly margin of said road; thence northeasterly along said northwesterly margin to the west line of the east 50 feet of said section; thence southerly along said west line to the true point of beginning.

on the 15th day of August, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Daylight Saving Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.


Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.
