The north half of the south half of the NE quarter of the SW quarter of Section 20, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., EXCEPT County Road; TOGETHER WITH the south half of the north half of the NE quarter of the SW quarter of Section 20, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, EXCEPT the following described parcel: Beginning at a point on the east line of the west 40 feet of said subdivision, which is N 0057'00" E 120 feet measured along said east line from the south line of said subdivision; thence S 88022'40" E parallel with south line 180 feet; thence S 0°57'00" W 90 feet; thence S 88°22'40" E 276 feet; thence N $0^{\circ}57'00"$ E 303.64 feet to the north line of said subdivision; thence N 88026'45"Walong said north line 456.00 feet to the east line of 104th Avenue N.E.; thence southerly along southeast line 213.29 feet more or less to point of beginning.
