RESOLUTION NO. 1365

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. 65-S-78 for the improvement of S.E. 30th Street, from the Henry Richards Road easterly to the east line of the Plat of Mercer Slough Garden Tracts; and authorizing payment of miscellaneous expenses.

WHEREAS the City Council did on October 4, 1966, pass Ordinance No. 939 for the improvement of S.E. 30th Street, from Henry Richards Road easterly to the east line of the Plat of Mercer Slough Garden Tracts, by paving and otherwise improving the same, which ordinance was thereafter amended by Ordinance No. 1041 passed June 6, 1967, and did create Local Improvement District No. 65-S-78 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed, and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant No. 1, dated June 26, 1967	\$33,890.24
Warrant No. 2, dated July 25, 1967	10,118.25

AND WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

Water District No. 68, repair broken main	50.29

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$ 4,113.24, to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Statewide City Employees Retirement System, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
