RESOLUTION NO. 1373

A RESOLUTION regarding Planned Unit Development No. 12, and expressing concurrence of the Council with the recommendation of the Planning Commission as to the preliminary proposal.

WHEREAS the owner of the following-described property filed an application for a Planned Unit Development, by submitting a preliminary proposal to the City Planning Department for study of the proposed development and its vicinity; and

WHEREAS following the Department's review and finding that the preliminary proposal met the minimum defined standards, a public hearing was held before the Planning Commission, and thereafter the Commission did tentatively approve the proposed Planned Unit Development, and did forward the same to the Council for review; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby concur with the Planning Commission, and does tentatively approve the proposed Planned Unit Development, upon the application of Redford, and as to the following-described parcel:

The N 200' of the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 29, T25N, R5E, W.M., except the E 1/2 thereof less roads; together with the E 330' of S 132' of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 29, T25N, R5E, W.M., less roads.

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Section 2. Those certain preliminary drawings, filed under Clerk's receiving number 1445, which drawings set and fix the designated conditions of the Planned Unit Development aforesaid, and commonly known as Planned Unit Development No. 12, are hereby approved by this reference.
