RESOLUTION NO. 1383

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing to vacate a portion of S.E. 40th Street between the Northern Pacific Railway right-of-way and Lake Washington Boulevard, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Wiborg and others for the vacation of:

That portion of Louisa Street (now known as S.E. 40th Street) as shown on the Plat of Mercer Addition, Volume 17 of Plats, page 8, records of King County, Washington, in the City of Bellevue lying westerly of the Northern Pacific Railway right-of-way and easterly of the easterly margin of Lake Washington Boulevard (also known as 118th Avenue S.E.).

on the 20th day of November, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
