RESOLUTION NO. 1394

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing to vacate a portion of 112th Avenue N.E., in the vicinity of N.E. 19th Place, within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of Day for the vacation of:

That portion of 112th Avenue N.E. in the City of Bellevue lying in the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 and in the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 25 N, Range 5 E, lying east of a line 50 feet easterly of and parallel with the centerline of 112th Avenue N.E.

on the 15th day of January, 1968, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
