RESOLUTION NO. 1396

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing to consider the vacation of a 10-foot strip of land originally intended to be a portion of N.E. 5th Street, west of 124th Avenue N.E., within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That on the Council's motion, a public hearing be had upon the matter of the vacation of:

The S. 10 feet of the N. 30 feet of the E. 1/2 of the S. 310 feet of the S. 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, Twp. 25N, R. 5E., W.M., in the City of Bellevue,

on the 15th day of January, 1968, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Standard Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council chambers at the Municipal Building, 111 - 116th Avenue S.E., in Bellevue, Washington.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law, inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing and to speak for or against the granting of the said petition.

Section 3. That inasmuch as this resolution is upon the Council's own motion, that there shall be given by mail at least 15 days before the date fixed for the hearing, a similar notice to the owners or reputed owners of all lots, tracts, or parcels of land or other property abutting upon such street sought to be vacated, as shown on the rolls of the County Treasurer, and directed to the address thereon shown.

Section 4. That the matter be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
