RESOLUTION NO. 1401

A RESOLUTION relating to the 1968 Budget; and making transfers between general classes within funds.

WHEREAS Section 35.33.120 of Chapter 7 of the Laws of 1965, as embodied in R.C.W. 35.33.120, permits the City Council to readjust the municipal budget by making transfers between the general classes, when authorized by resolution duly adopted by the majority vote of all members of the Council; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby find that those monies heretofore appropriated by the 1968 Budget Ordinance No. 1106, approved by the City Council on October 2, 1967, and all amendments thereto, for the accounting divisions, classes and items listed below are not required for the City's operation in 1968 to the extent by which said accounting divisions, classes and items are decreased in Section 4 below; and that the accounting divisions, classes and items listed in Section 5 below require more funds for expenditure in 1968 than had been anticipated or were available in making appropriations in Ordinance No. 1106, as amended; and that it is to the best interests of the municipality to transfer monies appropriated in Ordinance No. 1106, as amended, so that the monies so transferred and reappropriated herein can be more advantageously expended in the rendition of municipal service in the year 1968.

Section 2. No portion of the monies so transferred shall be used to increase the salary of any employee above that provided for in the 1968 Budget and such transfer and reappropriation of monies herein will not constitute an increase or decrease of the entire budget of expenditure estimated and appropriated for the year 1968 by Ordinance No. 1106, and all amendments thereto.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 1106, as amended, classifying and itemizing the estimated expenditures of municipal funds for the year 1968 be, and the same hereby is, amended to the extent by which accounting divisions, classes and items are decreased in Section 4 hereof, and to the extent that transfers of monies are made to accounting divisions, classes and items of expenditures as contained in Section 5 hereof.

Section 4. Subject to the existence of unexpanded monies in the below listed items, the appropriation for such items as contained in Ordinance No. 1106, as amended, is recalled, revoked and decreased to the following extent:


