THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the name of the waterfront tract of approximately 18 acres, recently acquired from Middleton M. Chism and Catherine G. Chism, on the easterly shore of Lake Washington at approximately S.E. 13th Street, be named CHISM PARK.
