CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 2223

A RESOLUTION regarding the City of Bellevue Affirmative Action Plan.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following shall be the policy of the City of Bellevue:

- A. Affirmatively assure that municipal employment including employment on all city boards, agencies, committees and commissions is in keeping with the principle of equal opportunity, and to reaffirm equal opportunity in all municipal personnel-related actions.
- B. Carry out the spirit of Federal, State, and local laws and regulations prohibiting discrimination in employment on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex or age.
- C. Recruit, hire and promote all categories of job classification without regard to race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex or age.
- D. Base decisions concerning employment and promotion in accordance with the principle of equal employment opportunity by imposing only valid, performance-related requirements with regard to employment and promotion opportunities.
- E. Administer all other personnel actions, such as compensation, benefits, municipally-sponspred training, education, tuition assistance, social and recreational programs, without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age.
- F. Conduct annual analysis of all personnel-related actions to insure equal opportunity at all levels, in all classifications and activities.

Section 2. In order to promote the policies set forth in Section I above, the City Council hereby adopts as the policy of the City of Bellevue the statement of goals contained in that certain document received under Clerk's Receiving No. 26/2 which document is incorporated herein by reference.
