

RESOLUTION NO. 39

A RESOLUTION authorizing and requesting the King County Engineer to continue checking applications for plats within the City of Bellevue, filed prior to the incorporation thereof, until further notice.

WHEREAS, certain applications for approval of plats of land, lying within the area now constituting the City of Bellevue, were pending before the King County Commissioners prior to the incorporation of Bellevue as a city, and in connection therewith certain road bonds were filed with said Engineer and certain checking fees were paid to the King County Auditor, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue is not ready to assume the responsibility of office and field checking of the proposed plats of land within the boundaries of Bellevue; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the specifications of the King County Road Engineer for installation of county roads be observed by said Engineer in inspecting newly installed roads and in checking for compliance of proposed plats in the City of Bellevue with the platting resolution, which by reference has adopted the subdivision standards and regulations of the King County Planning Commission and platting resolution of said King County Planning Commission No. 11048.

Section 2. That the King County Road Engineer continue making further office and field checks of the accuracy of courses and locations of stakes and monuments and compliance with county road specifications in connection with the proposed plats of land lying within the boundaries of the City of Bellevue.


Section 3. Upon completion of the Engineer's examination and satisfactory compliance of the platting requirements by the developer, the Engineer is requested to affix his approval to said plat and to inform the Bellevue Planning Commission thereof.

Section 4. After the County Engineer has completed the checking of the plat, he shall forward to the County Treasurer a statement of the checking charges incurred. The County Treasurer upon receipt of the statement shall credit to the Road District Fund the cost of checking the plat and shall refund to the platter the difference between the checking charges and the amount deposited or shall require the platter to pay the difference if the checking charges are greater than the amount deposited.

Section 5. A certified copy of this resolution shall be prepared and delivered to the King County Engineer.

Section 6. This resolution shall be in full force and effect on and after the date of its execution.
