RESOLUTION NO. 4841

A RESOLUTION accepting the Municipal Facilities Program for the City of Bellevue adopting certain implementation guidelines thereto, and directing staff to implement designated portions of said Program.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has a responsibility to provide services for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City has verified the need for an organized and planned process to provide public facilities to support such services; and

WHEREAS, a program has been prepared which describes the approximate type, kind, and size of facilities to support present and future City services; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of such program requires both fiscal responsibility and timeliness of actions; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following municipal facilities implementation guidelines are hereby adopted:


- a. That the needs identified in the Municipal Facilities Program (March, 1986) prepared by a consultant retained by the City are reasonable estimates for purposes of implementation.
- b. That the facilities identified in the Program should be located so as to most effectively serve the population of the City.
- c. That centralization of support services is encouraged.
- d. That the existing City Hall building and site should form the nucleus for a City Administrative campus.
- e. That whenever possible sale and/or trade of non-City Hall land should be considered in developing future maintenance and operations facilities and/or site(s).
- f. That cost efficiencies and timeliness shall be a consideration in any future facility development.

Section 2. The Municipal Facilities Program (March, 1986) is hereby accepted and City staff is directed to initiate acquisition of office space and development of a new Municipal Services Center site consistent with the implementation guidelines adopted in Section 1 above and consistent with the staff analysis for implementation.


